TOWNSHIP OF ARMADA COUNTY OF MACOMB ORDINANCE NO. 113-37 ADOPTION OF UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE

Title

An Ordinance securing the public health, safety and general welfare of the residents and property owners of Armada Township, through the adoption of the Uniform Traffic Code, prescribing criminal penalties and civil sanctions for the violation thereof, and repealing all Ordinances and/or Resolutions in conflict therewith.

THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ARMADA, MACOMB COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

Section 1. Short Title.

This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the Armada Township Uniform Traffic Code Ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to protect the public health, safety, and general welfare of the property and persons in the Township of Armada from persons who violate the provisions of the Uniform Traffic Code as promulgated by the Director of the Department of State Police.

Section 3. Authority.

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to and in accordance with MCL 257.951; MSA 9.2651, as amended, being Act No. 62 of the Public Acts of Michigan of 1956.

Section 4. Adoption of the Uniform Traffic Code - By Reference.

The Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages, promulgated by the Commissioner of State Police and published in the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code and amendments as published in the quarterly supplement No. 5 to the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code, in accordance with 1956 Public Act No. 62 is hereby adopted by reference as modified in this Ordinance. Copies of the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages shall be kept on file at the Township Clerk's office and be available for copying, inspection and/or purchase by the public, during regular business hours.

Section 5. References in Code.

References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages to the term "government unit" shall mean the Township of Armada.

Section 6. Repeal of Conflicting Provisions.

All Resolutions, Ordinances or parts thereof conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extend of such conflict hereby repealed.

Section 7. Severability.

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality of said section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not effect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 8. Publication.

A true copy of this Ordinance of summary thereof shall be published in the Romeo Observer, a newspaper of general circulation in the Township of Armada.

Section 9. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after the publication of a true copy or summary thereof as provided in Section 8.
