Bid Specifications

Waste Hauler Services Contract

Service Days/Times

Services are to be performed on the 2nd and 4th Saturday of the month, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Large Item Pickup shall be the 2nd Saturday of April and October, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Usage Data

A vehicle count was performed by the Macomb County Department of Roads on four collection days in March and April 2013. The highest recorded vehicle count during this time was approximately 700 vehicles.

Insurance

Proof of general liability insurance not less than \$1 million and worker's compensation or sole proprietor statement shall be provided with bid. Armada Township shall be listed as an additional insured on general liability insurance.

Pay Items

Garbage Disposal Containers

Payment shall include all costs to provide one laborer and sufficient containers to collect all accepted garbage items from township residents during the times required by the contract and to properly dispose of all collected items. Containers must be intended for garbage collection such as packer trucks or roll-off containers. All containers and vehicles must be removed from the site by the end of the collection day. Laborer shall assist in directing vehicles to the proper containers.

Recycling Collection Containers

Payment shall include all costs to provide one laborer and sufficient containers to collect all accepted recyclable items from township residents during the times required by the contract and to properly dispose of all collected items. Containers must be suitable for recycle collection. The waste hauler must include delivery tickets signed by the recycle facility with each invoice for *Recycling Collection Containers*. Waste hauler must provide sufficient containers to properly sort materials as required by the recycling facility. All containers and vehicles must be removed from the site by the end of the collection day. Laborer shall assist in directing vehicles to the proper containers.
